<b>Great Black-backed Gull</b>	24/7	4 ringed Annet; rough count gave 120 adults, 120+ juveniles; noted that there seems to be a significant increase on Annet/St Agnes compared with 4 years ago - they seem to have displaced Fulmars on Carn Irish

<b>Kittiwake</b>	22/7	Gugh: 29 chicks (21 ringed) from 22 nests; 53 empty nests, many apparently predated - no fledged birds evident, nor surplus adults
<b>Common Tern</b>		Colony on south end of Annet:
